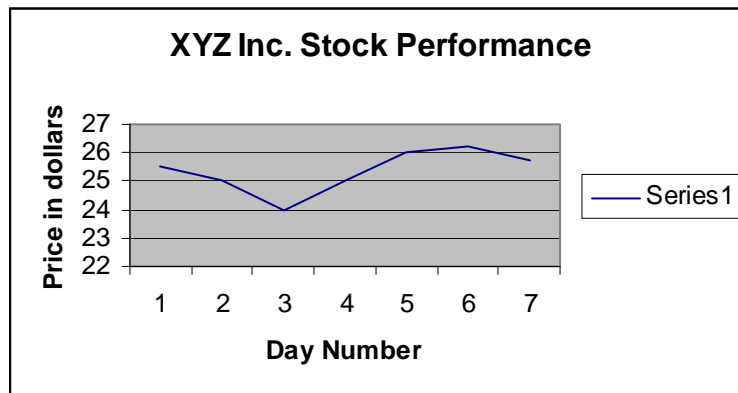


Final Stock Project

Your final stock project will be an electronic presentation of your stock portfolio performance.

Your project must include a P/L (profit and loss) sheet explaining your investment performance, numerically and graphically, for each stock you have owned. A simple line graph will suffice. No misleading graphs here, although you should be able to see how you could mislead someone about your investment performance via a misleading graph. Your conclusion must be in essay form and must include an explanation of your investment portfolio performance as a whole, as well as any important information regarding any specific stock that had a significant effect on your overall portfolio performance.

Sample P/L sheet PowerPoint slide:



Purchased 100 shares of XYZ at \$25 $\frac{1}{2}$. Sold all shares at \$25 $\frac{3}{4}$. Earned \$25.00 profit.

Conclusion portion: I earned approximately 1% profit while owning XYZ Inc. stock for only one week, or approximately a 52% annual rate of return. This is a substantial profit.

Don't forget, your last slide must be your final conclusions based on your overall investment portfolio performance. Good luck, work hard, and create something you can be proud of.
